Question: What are the dangers of thinking we know enough of Jesus?

I. The Context: From "There" to his Hometown (vs. 1)

II. The Reaction: Don't we Already Know Enough of Him? (vs. 2-3)

III. In the Context of a Lack of Faith - No Power is Seen (vs. 4-6)

IV. An Attitude Seen By Us?

A. Producing a failure to hear the gospel or...

B. Producing a lack of wonder concerning the gospel

Point to Ponder: To what extent have we lost an awestruck wonder of the gospel and failed to see its power to transform lives? How much of that condition can be traced to our failure to hunger for more of our Savior - and instead find ourselves simply relying on what we already know from years ago?
