~God is not blind toward them

Point to Ponder: *"So the law was put in charge to lead us to Christ that we might be justified by faith" (Gal. 3:24).* The law is a standard meant to sober us concerning our sin - which in turn is meant to lead us to the only one who can rescue us from sin's consequence - namely Jesus. God's justice should certainly assure us that others will not get off scot-free, and sober us concerning our own guilt, but the real question is: has it led us to the good news of what God has done in Jesus which in turn should amaze us?
