I. Question: For whom did Jesus Come?

II. The Call and Response (27-29)

- A. The call: Follow me!
- B. The response:
 - 1. He followed
 - 2. Threw and banquet for Jesus

III. The Response to the Response (30)

~ with tax collectors and sinners - really?

IV. The Answer (31-32)

~ He came for sinners!

"Here is trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners - of whom I am the worst." (1 Timothy 1:15)

Point to Ponder: Ask: If there is at least a little Pharisee in all of us where would I find it in my life? Then let's sit at table with Jesus watching and learning from Him.
