***Journeying Home:
Longing for Someone in Whom we can Rest
Psalm 131***

Question: When life seems to be a breeding ground for restlessness, where can we find rest?

I. Resting in God's Sovereignty (1)

~faithful aspiration vs.
presumptuous worldly ambition

II. Resting in God's Goodness (2)

~childlike contentedness vs.
infantile demanding and dependency

III. Resting in God's Purpose (3)

~hope in the Lord for the long-haul vs.
striving for short-sighted and selfish desires

Point to Ponder: Consider taking some time this coming week and pray a "request free" prayer. Recount His goodness to you, remember with Him times when you delighted in Him, praise Him for His attributes by recounting the mercy and grace He has shown you. Tell Him how you have placed your hope in Him and of your growing longing to find rest in Him.
