**Point to Ponder:** Think of someone within this fellowship for whom this statement would be true: theologically you have every reason to know the sweetness of unity (after all, you are one in Christ); but from a worldly perspective you would have no reason at all to know unity (your personalities, age, and political persuasions differ, or worst of all they don't root for the Eagles). During this season of Advent seek to build a greater relationship with that individual than you had before (seek them out at Coffee fellowship, send them a Christmas card telling them how much you appreciate them...).

**Next Week:** Next Sunday begins the Season of Advent. This is a season designed to prepare us to celebrate rightly our God coming in flesh (the incarnation). It is a season that is meant to train our hearts to wait for the Lord. As we remember those who waited for His first coming, we can learn to wait for His coming again. As we gather in worship in Advent we will be looking at "*Songs of our Savior's Coming*" - namely poetic outbursts by those who were waiting for Jesus. The first "song" is that of Mary found in **Luke 1:46-55** (*The Magnificat* - which is Latin for magnifies as in "My soul magnifies the Lord.")
