Fighting for the Gospel
1 Timothy 1:18-20

Question: As followers of Jesus, to what should we call each other?

I. Fighting for the Gospel in our Lives (vs. 18-19a)

“You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.” (1 Corinthians 6:19b-20)

II. Fighting for the Gospel in the Church (vs. 19b-20)

“remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine...” (1 Timothy 1:3b)

Point to Ponder: How might the gospel inform common life situations like: when we struggle with our true worth, when we wrestle with our identity, when we feel beaten down by our sin? To whom might the Spirit be leading us to apply the gospel?
