We've Been Redeemed!

What does "redeemed" mean?

Deliverance from some evil at a price

Redeemed from what?

An empty way of life handed down to us by our forbearers

How are we redeemed?

Nothing but the blood (not by the things the world treasures)

What then is our response?

You need to answer this question _____

Points to Ponder: We have been redeemed from an empty way of life. How much of our life is still lived by the standards of that empty life and how much of our goals and labor is informed by the fact that we have been redeemed by a wondrous savior? This week, let's spend some time doing a personal life inventory along these lines.
