Faith and Righteousness
Genesis 15:1-6

Question: Where can we find help to go on believing?

I. God's Word of Comfort for the Fearful (vs. 1)

II. God's Promise Confirmed for the Doubting (vs. 2-5)

"Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you." (1Pet. 5:7)

III. God's Promise Believed and Credited as Righteousness (vs. 6)

"But the words 'it was counted to him' were not written for his sake alone but for ours also. It will be counted to us who believe in him who raised from the dead Jesus our Lord, who was delivered up for our trespasses and raised for our justification." (Rom. 4:23-25)

"Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you. My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever." (Ps. 73:24-25)

Point to Ponder: When we have a hard time seeing the promises of God coming true in our life what is our response? Do we cast all our anxiety on him? Do we place our faith in a God greater than ourself – recognizing that we have no one in heaven but Him?
