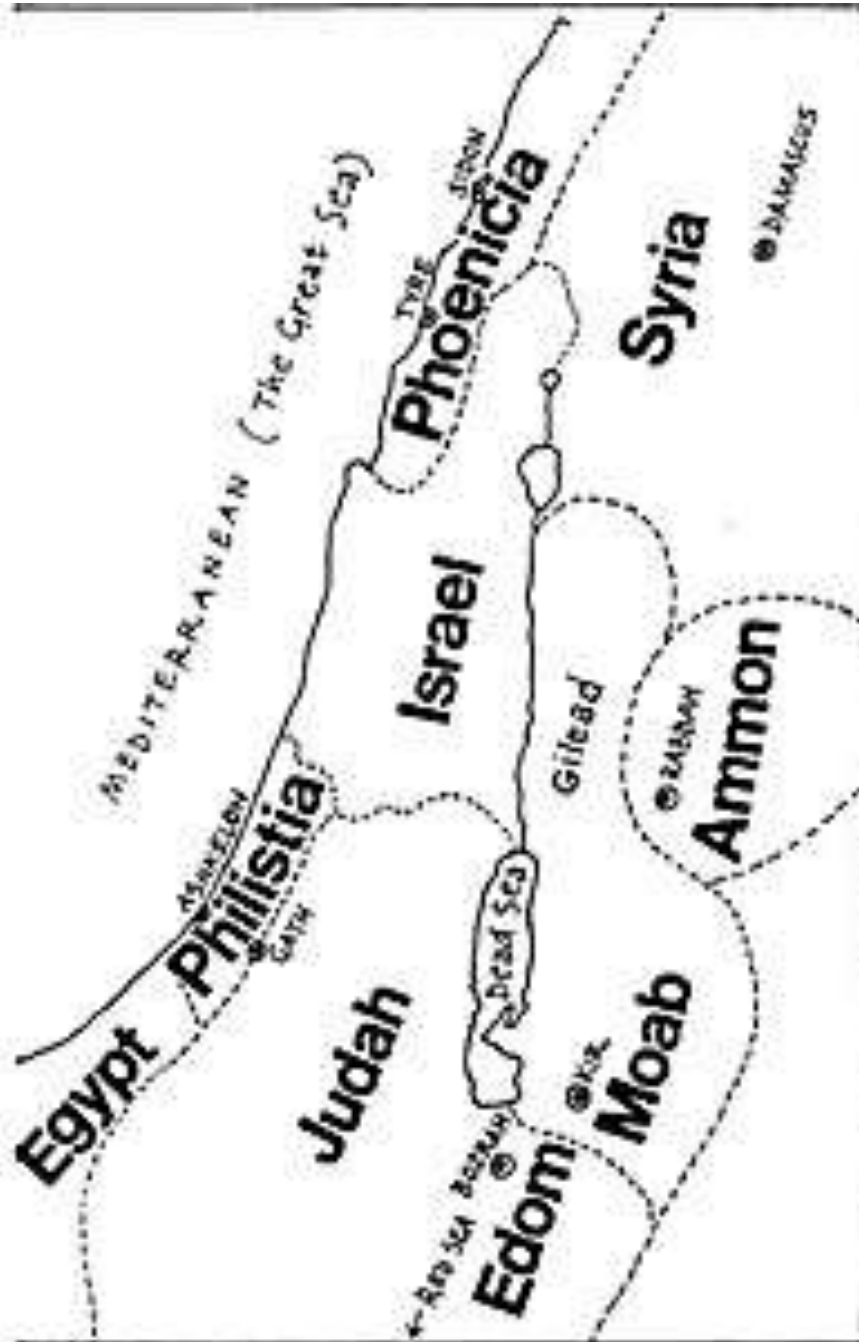
- A. The Sins: a disregard for social justice and sexual sin (2:6-8)

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**Point to Ponder:** Read Hebrews 4:12-13 and then ask: can I hide anything from God? Then continue reading the exhortation of Hebrews 4:14-16 and then ask: why would I not run to the throne of grace and there find grace from the one who is able to sympathize with us in our weakness?
