

Words from the Cross
It Is Finished
John 19:30

Question: What did Jesus mean when he said: "It is finished"?

*"See, we are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written about the Son of Man by the prophets will be **accomplished**."* (spoken by Jesus Lk.19:31; emphasis mine, the same word as Jn. 19:30's "finished")

"For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." (spoken by Jesus about himself - Lk.19:10)

"The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners." (written by Paul - 1Tim. 1:15)

"For the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and go give his life as a ransom for many." (spoken by Jesus concerning himself – Mk. 10:45)

Point to Ponder: If Jesus work is done, finished; if there is nothing we can add to it; then the only question is do we entrust ourselves to Him?
