I. **Strong Words to the Cows of Bashan (vs.1-3)**

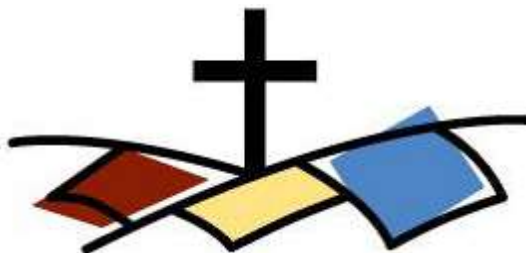
II. **Religion is No Cover for Our Sin (vs. 4-5)**

Have we listened to a sermon, or been a part of a Bible Study which has teed up a truth from God's Word that should shape our lives; yet we simply let it sit on the page of our Bible? Have the words of a brother or sister in Christ only served to make us defensive, but failed to challenge our ways? Let's together pray that God's Spirit might make us more sensitive and responsive to the spiritual cues God brings our way.
