Psalm 94

I. Do Not be Indifferent to Injustice (1-7)

~ Cry out to the Lord - use your words!

II. Do Not Fret Over God Being Blind (8-11)

~ He Sees and Knows it All!

III. Do Not be Unaware of God Shaping us Through Hard Times (12-15)

~ Take Comfort in Knowing we are His

IV. Do Not Fail to Trust in the Lord (16-23)

~ He will show us grace in the present and one day make all things right

Point to Ponder: Because we follow one who is often called “the suffering Servant,” we can expect that our life will often be marked by hardship brought on by wicked people. We know that God was working out His great purpose in and through the suffering and death of our Lord. Because we follow after him, we should not be surprised that God is working out His purpose in and through our hardships. We have his assurance: “*And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose* (Rom. 8:28).” Think back on hard times you have faced, and ask the Lord: “how did you use that to shape me to be more like Jesus? Or, how did you use that to draw me to yourself?”
