Mark 14:12-25

Question: Why would Jesus die?

I. A Death with Intention (12-21)

II. A Death with Great Meaning for Many (22-25)

A. Saved from Judgment (it passes over me to Him)

B. Saved for Fellowship (with the One who has so greatly loved us)

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**Point to Ponder:** Next week we will celebrate this meal instituted by our Lord. How will we prepare ourselves? At what will we marvel as we eat the bread and drink from the cup? Perhaps you would join me in memorizing 1 Peter 3:18a – repeating it again and again in our minds as a “breath-prayer of praise” to our Lord who would go to such great lengths in order that He “might bring us to God.”

**A Note to Parents:** Please know that the children and youth who leave the service during the sermon are looking at the same passage we will consider each week. We hope that you will initiate a conversation with them about this portion of God’s Word.
