**Question: What does right worship look like?**

**Answer in part:** an expressive corporate response to who we know God to be and a softened heart towards His voice.

**I. An Expressive Corporate response to the God We Know (vs. 1-7c)**

- A. A Call to Worship
- B. A Call to Corporate Worship
- C. A Call to Participatory and Expressive Worship
- D. A Call to Worship God (an audience of One)

**II. A Softened (not hard) Heart toward God's Voice (vs. 7d-11)**

- A. Note the urgency (today)
- B. Note the sobering historical examples
  1. Meribah (read Exodus 17:1-7 for context)
  2. Massah (Numbers 20:1-13)
