2 Kings 6:24-7:20

Question: What's Good About the Good News of God?

I. It is Good News Addressing Desperate Circumstances (6:24-7:2)
~ it meets real needs

II. It is Good News Experienced by the Most Unlikely (7:3-20)
~ they find that it is too good not to tell others

III. It is Good News that Should Sound Strangely Familiar
~ the parallels to the gospel are no accident

Point to Ponder: There is no surprise that we label the central message we seek to proclaim to the world as: Good News. Yet have we really found it as such? Before we answer that question, let's ponder the answers to these questions: does our life demonstrate that we have found this news as too good not to tell others? When we tell our story, do we speak about the time we received Jesus as: A Day of Good News?
