Priorities of One In Christ
Colossians 3:15-17

Question: What should the church look like?

I. Let the Peace of Christ Rule in your Hearts (15)

~ speaking of what Jesus accomplished: “making peace by the blood of his cross.” (Col. 1:20b)

~ “But whoever would be great among you must be your servant, and whoever would be first among you must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.” (Mk. 10:43b-45)

II. Let the Word of Christ Dwell in you Richly (16)

III. Do Everything in the Name of Jesus (17)

~ “So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do it all to the glory of God.” (1 Cor. 10:31)

Point to Ponder: Do an assessment of what you see in our life together with followers of Jesus at Great Valley. How and where have you seen the peace of Christ determining things, the Word of Christ richly dwelling in us, and a clear sense that everything is being done in His name?
