Two Ways of Life – A Decision
Matthew 7:13-27

Question: Where is my life headed in the long run?

I. Two Paths (13-14)

Q. On what road am I?

II. Two Prophets (15-20)

Q. To whom is my heart listening?

III. Two People (21-23)

Q. Behind the façade, who am I really?

IV. Two Purposes (24-27)

Q. What am I building with my life?

Point to Ponder: The answers we give to the questions raised by Jesus words, will determine things of greatest importance! So, let's ask: What is my decision? Ask that question remembering that failing to make a decision, is a decision already made.
