The Thresholds Shake
Amos 9:1-10

Question: What's good about the Good News we proclaim?

I. No One Will Escape (vs. 1)

II. No Where to Hide (vs. 2-4)

III. No One Like the Lord God of Hosts (vs. 5-6)

IV. No One is Beyond Judgement (7-10)

"Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, for our God is a consuming fire" (Hebrews 12:28)

Point to Ponder: Hope can only be born out of something we lack. Salvation can only come when there is a threat before us. If we find ourselves yawning at the gospel it may mean we need to look again at our sin and the judgement it deserves.
