Abraham - A Journey of Faith Judgment on Sodom and Us Genesis 19:1-38

Question: How should we rightly respond to God's judgement that many find so troubling and distasteful?

 28 Likewise, just as it was in the days of Lot—they were eating and drinking, buying and selling, planting and building, 29 but on the day when Lot went out from Sodom, fire and sulfur rained from heaven and destroyed them all— 30 so will it be on the day when the Son of Man is revealed. Lk. 17:28-30 (Jesus speaking to his disciples)

⁷ just as Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding cities, which likewise indulged in sexual immorality and pursued unnatural desire, serve as an example by undergoing a punishment of eternal fire. Jude 7



²³ And you, Capernaum, will you be exalted to heaven? You will be brought down to Hades. For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. ²⁴ But I tell you that it will be more tolerable on the day of judgment for the land of Sodom than for you." Mt. 11:23-24 (Jesus speaking)

"Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved... Acts 16:30b-31a (The jailer asking a question which is answered by Paul and Silas)

Point to Ponder: When it comes to the mention of judgment who are we most like: a) Lot's future sons-in-law who thought it was a joke, b) Lots wife – who couldn't keep her eyes off the things of this world, or c) the Philippian jailer who asked what must I do to be saved?
