A Faith that Falters
Genesis 12:10-20

Question: What should we make of God's great promises when...?

I. When Life seems to Threaten (vs. 10)

"In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world (Jn. 16:33)."

II. When Sin seems to Jeopardize (11-16)

"but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more...(Rom. 5:20b)"

III. When the Powerful seem to Hold All the Cards (17-20)

"No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord (Rom. 8:37-39)."

Point to Ponder: When are we most likely to think that God's good purpose for us might be lost? Meditate on Rom. 8:37-39 asking the Lord for help believing its truths.
