Psalm 24

Question: How can we know nearness to the strong and mighty King of Glory?

I. Knowing the Extent of the King of Glory's Kingdom (1-2)

~ "There is not one square inch of the entire creation about which Jesus Christ does not cry out, 'This is mine.'" - Kuyper

II. Knowing the Requirements of Coming Near to the King of Glory (3-6)

~ "...and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin." 1 Jn 1:7b

III. Are we Ready to Welcome the strong and mighty King of Glory? (7-10)

~ "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come into him and eat with him, and he with me." Rev. 3:20

Point to Ponder: It is mind boggling that we can know nearness with the King of Glory. How then can we take advantage of that? Where, how and when do we need to hear the call to swing wide the door for the King of Glory to come in?
