Joining God on His Mission Telling it Slant* for the Mission Acts 17:16-34

Question: How can we join God on his Mission as a witness to those who know little (or nothing) of the God we worship

I. Eyes that See Through a Kingdom Lens (16-21)

II. Speech that Awakens Unacknowledged Realities (22-29)

III. Words that Point to Weighty Implications (30-34)

Point to Ponder: If we look through a kingdom lens, what do we see in our workplace, our neighborhood, and our extended family? Is there anything that provokes us? As we look at the lives of those who do not know Jesus, can we somehow awaken in them a longing for God? How might we come at this truth in a manner that is fresh – how can we "tell all the truth, but tell it slant?"
