Question: How do we rightly discern our own lives and the lives of others?

I. Do Not Relate Judgmentally to Others (1-2) – see Mt. 18:15, 7:15

II. Do Not Relate Hypocritically to Others (3-5)

III. Do Not Relate Indiscriminately to Others (6) – see Pr. 23:9, Mt. 10:11-15

Point to Ponder: Which of those three calls (see above) do we most need to hear?
