Faith in the Face of Death

Genesis 23:1-20

Question: Do you ever feel like a stranger in a strange land? Does your heart long for a homeland that you can't quite touch or even see?

I. The Problem - vs. 1-6

II. The Proposal – vs. 7-16

III. The Possession – vs. 17-20 (17:8, Dt. 32:48-49, Josh. 22:4, Ps. 2:7-8, Ob. 15,17,21)

"To your offspring I will give this land" – (God promises Abram in 12:7)

"all the land that you see I will give to you and to your offspring forever" - (God promises Abram in 13:15)

"to your offspring I will give this land" – (God promises Abram in 15:18)

"I will give to you and to your offspring after you the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession, and I will be their God" 17:8

(Speaking of Abraham) "he was looking forward to the city that has foundations whose designer and builder is God." Heb. 11:10

(Speaking of those who speak like Abraham): "People who say such things show they are looking for a country of their own...They were longing for a better country – a heavenly one. Therefore, God is not ashamed to be called their God, for He has prepared a city for them." Heb. 11:14.16b

"We wait for new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness dwells" 2 Pet. 3:13

"Look! God's dwelling place is now among the people and he will dwell with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." Rev. 21:3b-4
