O Come All Ye Unfaithful A Savior for Those Far Off Matthew 2:1-12

I. People Far-Off Seeking (vs. 1-2)

II. People Far-Off Searching (vs. 3-8)

III. People Far-Off Finding (vs. 9-12)

"For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are <u>far off</u>, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself. (Acts 2:39)

"Therefore....remember that you were at that time separated from Christ, alienated from the commonwealth of Israel and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world. But now in Christ Jesus you who were once <u>far off</u> have been brought near by the blood of Christ." (portion of Eph. 2:11-13)

Point to Ponder: Have you been seeking, but not finding? Do you feel far-off from truths that satisfy your greatest longings? Then know that God stepped down into history to rescue people like you.
