**A Full Heart in Christ**  
Colossians 4:13-18

**I. A People Changed by the Gospel of Christ**

*“we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus...” and “the gospel , which has come to you, as indeed in the whole world it is bearing fruit and increasing as it also does among you...” (1:4b,5b-6a)*

**II. A People Reminded of the Preeminence of Christ**

*“...all things were created through him and for him...For in him all the fullness of God was pleased to dwell, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether on earth or in heaven, making peace with the blood of his cross.” (1:16b;19)*

**III. A People Threatened By Confusion about Christ**

*“I say this in order that no one may delude you with plausible arguments...See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit...” (2:4,8a)*

**IV. A People Whose Identity is Found in Christ**

*“you have been raised with Christ...you have died, and your life is hidden in Christ in God. When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.” (3:1a,3b-4)*

**V. A People Whose Lives Should be Ruled by Christ**

*“...let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts...let the word of Christ dwell in you richly...and whatever you do...do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus.” (3:15b,16a,17a,c)*
