Open Our Eyes Lord
2 Kings 6:24-7:20

Question: To what are we blind and how can we see?

I. Do You See Our God Who Sees All? (8-14)

“And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.” (Hebrews 4:13)

II. Do You See Our God Who Is Able? (15-17)

“Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for he who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.” (1 John 4:4)

“Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels?” (Matthew 26:53)

“And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.” (Romans 8:28)

III. Do You See This World As It Is? (18-23)

“We grope for the wall like the blind; we grope like those who have no eyes; we stumble at noon as in the twilight...” (Isaiah 59:10a)

Point to Ponder: We need to train our eyes to see things differently than those who do not belong to Jesus. To that end, will you pray with me the prayer of Ephesians 1:16-19 for Great Valley - that we might be given eyes to see?
